Cigars

Light

Hoyo de Monterrey Petit Robusto

£24.25

Dating back to 1865, the plantation lies on the banks of the San Juan y Martinez river. The flavour of the blend makes this cigar an attractive choice for those that seek a delicate yet aromatic Havana that is lighter to the taste but with great elegance and complexity.

Light –Medium

H. Upmann Half Corona

£17.35

The brand was first produced in Havana in 1844 and has been in Britain since the 1850's. A short smoke with a decent ring gauge that offers you classic H. Upmann's quality and taste with a presidential pedigree to boot!

Romeo Y Julieta No.3

£20.15

The brand, with its origins dating back to 1875, was named after Shakespeare's tragic lovers. It was a firm favourite of the Torcedores (rollers) and was read to them whilst they worked in the factories. This cigar delivers a balanced and aromatic smoke.

Cohiba Medio Siglo

£42.95

Originally created for President Fidel Castro in the then top secret El Laguito factory, Cohiba is the flagship brand of all the Havana's. Cohiba, in its purest form, is an ancient Taino Indian word for bunches of tobacco leaves and was first seen by Columbus in 1492 being smoked by the original inhabitants of Cuba. Cohiba – the world's finest cigar!

Montecristo Petit Tubos

£24.95

Named after Alexandre Dumas' famous novel "The Count of Montecristo", this brand sells more handmade cigars than any other in the world. This cigar is simply a No. 4 but, in a tube, and the brand is a benchmark for any cigar smoker. The tobacco delivers a small amount of spice initially complimented by the classic Montecristo citrus zing!

Partagas Serie D No. 4

£31.95

If there is one particularly famous cigar factory in Havana, it is Partagas. It can still be found at 520 Industria Street where it has been home to this iconic brand since it was opened in 1845 by Don Jaime Partagas. Immediately recognisable by its deep, earthy and spicy flavours. This cigar is full flavoured and is rich and complex with every puff. Sip do not gulp!
